Meeting called to order: 7:14

Acceptance of Minutes of last meeting: not available

Acceptance of Agenda: Anne motioned, seconded by Antonietta. All in Favor.

Correspondence: Kevin has sent in 4-5 scholarship letters for BC Soccer on behalf of local students. An e-mail has gone out concerning mini world cup, May 16th Nanaimo. All coaches must inform PRYSA if they are taking a team, so far there are a couple of teams intending to attend.

Business arising from March minutes: Year-end went well. There were many positive remarks. Antonietta will pick up gift cert (\$50 Lockerroom) for the 4 student coaches. A reminder to let coaches know to remind parents if any of their players are receiving awards. Extra pop etc was donated to Island Cup concession. Island Cup went well. Both Powell River teams did well with a 2 win, 1 close loss record. Nice weather and fields were in good shape.

Presidents Report: Tryouts for rep teams will continue in the spring as previous years. This year we are looking at the dates May 22nd 23rd. Discussion of older team players having other commitments which really cuts in to fielding a team. U17/18 girls started the season making cuts to sign a team of 20 girls. By Island cup they traveled with 11 girls to the final game. A discussion took place regarding role of UISA in PRYSA. There are many issues of concern. Kevin will attend the AGM April 25th. Prior to this there will be a presidents only meeting and he will inquire if other clubs have any of the same concerns. A request of minutes of UISA being put on website and a refundable entry fee to Island Cup (to discourage teams from dropping out after schedules are made)

Treasurer's Report: Antonietta reported that we are within budget, final bills to still be paid are field users fee, school board, trophies, scholarships and Haylstonz. She has received a \$320.00 reimbursement for officials for Provincial Cup from UISA. Antonietta will open an account for gaming funds as it is required in the application process.
