

Referees in Upper Island 2007 / 2008

The following items are to be followed for the season in the U-13 – U-18 age groups

- UISA Official Line-up and Misconduct forms are to be used for all games from u-13 to u-18 in the Upper Island League from the start of the season including Cup games. ONLY one form per game (home team to supply)
- ID cards will be used from the start of the season for all games and any player or team official's who does not have one MUST have it noted on UISA form, After Oct 15, 2007 ANY Player or Team Official who does not have an ID card CANNOT be involved in that game and cannot be on bench side
- The UISA forms must be filled out properly and completely before accepting them.
- Any Misconduct must be filled out on bottom of form with appropriate codes from back of form, NOT a check or an X. Remember to put score in before separating form and giving to appropriate coaches. If any RED cards are issued a separate Send Off form must be filled out and forwarded with game sheet to K. Cowie (information on back of UISA form). When filling out Send Off reports please give as much info as possible. Use second piece of paper if necessary. DO NOT KEEP THE ID CARD if send player off the field
- Forms with Misconduct or Information in misconduct area MUST be forwarded within 24 hrs. To K Cowie (info on back of UISA form). Forms without Misconduct should be forwarded every 2-3 weeks.
- Game reports are not needed by UISA, but your club may ask for one. These are not forwarded to UISA
- Teams and spectators will be on opposite sides of the field for all games. Team officials have been asked to help enforce this. Fields will have technical areas and spectator lines. If not, make note of in misconduct part of form. Team Officials must control technical area
- No coaching permitted from spectator side. Coach's have been made aware of this and asked to help enforce this. If unable to curtail this, make note in misconduct section of UISA form and forward.
- Please make sure that there is a team official of the same sex as the players on the bench.
- League games do not have to have a winner.
